**Legislative Update**—Several bills were presented and reviewed by Alex Zumbar, Dan Talarek, RJ Mancini and Kevin Futryk: HB 443, HB 493, HB 737, SB 366. Significant conversations, opinions, and comments ensued.

Government Advantage Group will continue to work collaboratively with Reps. Roemer and Hall on HB 737.

Committee members were encouraged to continue conversations with legislators over the summer.

There was no new legislation to review.

**Ohio Ethics Commission Opinion Issue:**

The Ohio Ethics Commission (Shiller) opinion was discussed. The committee noted that possible clarifying language for outside employment should be discussed. The Co-chairs appointed a subcommittee to review options and appointed Kathy Kelich, Jill Shiller, and Brad Cromes to serve with them.

**Old Business:**

The definition of late vs. delinquent taxes was discussed, and review will continue over the summer. No action taken.

Kevin presented background information on a public safety and parks issue that would require counties to compile a bed tax report. Language was not presented, and the committee will continue to monitor the issue. No action taken.

The committee concluded with discussion on manufactured homes legislation and HB 186 fallout. No action taken.
